The Armed Forces of Uzbekistan are the first in Central Asia, It ranks fourth among CIS countries and 54th among 140 countries of the world. January 14 is Defender of the Fatherland Day in Uzbekistan and the 30th anniversary of the Armed Forces was celebrated. On this date «"Yuksalish" Nation-wide movement announced the main figures and facts about the army in the form of an infographic. «Gazeta.uz analyzed the military power of Uzbekistan based on open data.[1] Armed Forces Ministry of Defense, Ministry of Internal Affairs, Ministry of Defense, National Guard, The relevant management bodies of the Ministry of

Foreign Affairs, other ministries, state committees and agencies, troops, military structures and institutions.[2] According to the defense doctrine, the defense policy of Uzbekistan is based on the following principles:

Except for cases of not using military force against other countries, suppressing and eliminating military aggression; The indivisibility of security, it is not allowed to strengthen one's own security at the expense of the security of other countries; Non-interference in the internal affairs of other countries, peaceful resolution of potential disputes; non-participation in military-political blocs, retain the right to withdraw from any interstate organization when it is transformed into a military-political bloc; defense adequacy; compliance of military construction with the nature of modern military conflicts; production, acquisition, storage of nuclear and other types of weapons of mass destruction, opt out of distribution and posting; Adherence to the principles of the treaty on a nuclear-weapon-free zone in Central Asia; not to allow foreign military bases and facilities to be placed on its territory; Non-participation of the Armed Forces in peacekeeping operations and military conflicts abroad; relying on spiritual and moral values and the cultural and civilizational identity of the people.[3] As reported by the press and media information service Uzbekistan is starting production of military equipment at the local level. In November 2017, the import substitute of the country's industry, development of the production potential of competitive and exportable military and bilateral products The State Committee of Defense Industry was established for this purpose. In November 2021, the production of domestically designed Kalkan light armored vehicles was launched.[4]

The role of the media in the image of the Uzbek army in the world is to introduce our army to the world and show our army as powerful. Military personnel of the country are successfully participating in the International Army Games. Having won 4 gold, 9 silver and 4 bronze medals at the ArMI-2021 Games, took 2nd place overall. In 2020, he won 3 contests among 30 participants of the Armi Games of Uzbekistan. He won prizes in 11 competitions and took the third place overall. The press-media service of the President informs about it.[5]

According to official sources, the military budget of the Republic is 692.5 mln. Makes a dollar. The number of weapons is as follows: tanks - 420, aircraft - 197, armored vehicles - 11,872, rocket weapons - 143, artillery - 197. The USSR left each republic with a large military potential in the past and a large variety of equipment, military bases and other supporting elements. Most countries took advantage of this and began to develop defense. Therefore, the army of Uzbekistan did not remain small in the world, rather, it was constantly increasing its numbers, and

today it is considered one of the largest armies in the Asian continent. But this is not surprising, because the government of this country spends 1.5 billion US dollars annually. These funds are spent on the production of weapons and increasing their number. The number of them is given in the following table. The army of Uzbekistan has great potential. There are 13,311,936 citizens eligible for military service in the Uzbek army. Annual appeal is about 600 thousand people.[6] In recent years, it has been part of the supply of troops with new weapons and equipment 27 percent of weapons and equipment were updated. In this regard, it was announced at the video meeting held on December 3 in the Defense and Security Committee of the Senate of the Oliy Majlis. In the video conference, the Armed Forces and the development of military construction and the provision of military security The information about the status of tasks performed during the 10th month of 2020 was heard. It was noted at the meeting that the Modeling and Simulation Field Training Center of the Ministry of Defense was newly established on the territory of the Chirchik landfill. To date, 160 commanders of tactical units and 23 officers of forces have studied at this center for the first time in a special training course. Mountain training training center, "Kattakurgon", "Termiz", "Angren" and "Sasagan" landfills were renovated in a new way in accordance with international requirements. Their educational and material bases are equipped with modern tools. In addition, the Ministry of Defense is considered the basis of an automated information system and database. "Mobilization" electronic database was established. According to the media and information service, "Army and People's Unity", "Three Generations Meeting", "Each Nurani is responsible for ten years".[7] Such phrases are becoming so embedded in the social life of our country that, as a result, ensuring the employment of young people, attract them to sports clubs, educate them in the spirit of military patriotism neighborhood, regional authorities, as well as the Ministry of Defense are directly involved. "Each Nurani is responsible for ten young people" held in cooperation with the Chirchik City Hall, the Council of Nurani and the Ministry of Defense The selection process is a clear example of the above points. Military personnel participated in the urban stage of the competition held in the meeting hall of the military unit located in the settlement, The assembly of citizens of four neighborhoods presented a fun day for the residents and young people. Because "Sun", "Kamalot", "Babur", "Youth" participated in the competition enlightened fathers and mothers, who are the chairmen of neighborhood citizens' assemblies, educate the young generation in the spirit of military patriotism, they showed their methods according to the conditions.
